


Why FJC?





Let me take you to Antwerp first...







Multi agency approach of violence against women has shown encouraging results, but there are still major obstacles:

- 1. Victims are still expected to travel to a variety of organisations to get safety, help and support
- 2. Victims have to tell their story over and over again

- ➤ A Family Justice Centre provides a wide range of co-ordinated services under one roof
- > Improving access for victims of domestic violence, child abuse and sexual abuse

GUIDING PRINCIPLES (1)

≻Safety Focused

Increase safety, promote healing, and foster empowerment through services for victims and their children

> Victim-centered

Provide victim-centered services that promote victim autonomy





GUIDING PRINCIPLES (2)

> Survivor-driven

Shape services to clients by asking them what they need

Empowered

Offer survivors a place to belong even after crisis intervention services are no longer necessary





GUIDING PRINCIPLES (3)

> Relationship-based

Maintain close working relationships among all collaborators/agencies

≻Offender-accountability

Increase offender accountability through evidence-based prosecution strategies and/or evidence based treatment programs.

Features of FJC

- All services under one roof
- Easy way of locating organizations and services
- Reduces travelling and waiting time
- Avoids repeated descriptions of the own situation
- Interdisciplinary cooperation on an individual case-by-case basis
- More information about the actions taken in the approach, the case manager has an overall view
- Combines security related information, quicker response is possible when new incidents, threats or changing circumstances occur
- Quick convening of a security conference
- Improvement of the interventions





Features of FJC

- Reduce the number of domestic/family violence, serious incidents and murders
- Reduce child abuse incidents
- Improved access and confidence in the delivery of Justice
- Professionals learn more about the possibilities of colleagues from other agencies
- > Improving working environment





Saving Lives – Reducing Costs

1 domestic violence murder will cost approximately £1.1 million



1 domestic violence murder prevented per year would provide savings equal to the total costs required to run the Family Justice Centre for a year – including all key partner agency staffing costs
